Rev. 12: 1-18

Vs. 12 "Let the heavens rejoice and all who live there; but for you, earth and sea, trouble is coming- because the devil has gone down to you in a rage, **knowing that his days are numbered."** Heaven rejoices that Jesus has come to redeem men.
